



Indoor and Outdoor Tennis Procedures and Protocols

Category	Item	Procedures and Protocols
Tennis	Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two metres (2m)/ six feet (6ft) social/physical distancing requirement in place at all times • All members are required to practice distancing while on the property • No handshakes, high fives, etc. • All members are asked not to touch the belongings of others • Masks are required by members entering the lobby (Staff behind plexiglass are exempt)
Tennis	Guest policy	No guests are permitted
Tennis	Ball usage	It is recommended that each player use their own balls, marked with a permanent marker. Whoever is serving uses their own balls. Other players can pass balls back to the owner by only using their racquet. Balls not in use can be set at the base of the net near the posts or the back of the court.
Tennis	Court Bookings / Court Times	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please exit your court as quickly as possible after the buzzer goes. For those waiting to go on court, please allow exiting members to pass through the gate before entering the court. • Bookings must be made in advance online or by calling the Front Desk: (604) 922-9722. No in person bookings allowed. • Changes must be made in advance of court time via online or by calling the Front Desk.
Tennis	Booking process	Usual Game time booking process (all players will be classified "suspended" until waiver is received)
Tennis	Club arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please enter and exit through the ground's gates closest to your court. • Know your court number before arrival and go directly to that court. • Please wait outside your designated court, leaving plenty of space for members to exit before making your way onto the court.
Tennis	Balls & Stringing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Balls can now be purchased in singles cans. Only credit card payment is accepted, no cash. • Stringing service will not be facilitated through the Club. You must contact Paul or Karin directly to coordinate pick up and drop off. paul@wvtc.ca or karin@wvtc.ca
Tennis	Ball Machine	Not available at this time
Clubhouse	Washrooms, Showers & Changing rooms	Maximum 2 people at any given time in the washroom/changeroom area. Showers are not available at this time.
Tennis	Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One coach to 4 students maximum • Only the instructors can touch the balls with their hands
Tennis	Waiver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All members must fill out the new waiver (link below). • Minors (under age 19) must fill out the Assumption of Risk form, a parent or guardian must complete the waiver on their behalf. • Waivers must be submitted before visiting the Club. Court access will not be permitted if you have not filled out the waiver. • The link to the waivers are below and must be returned via email to Sandy@wvtc.ca , or dropped off, or mailed to the Club.

Tennis	Policy enforcement	Tennis Professionals & Desk Staff will be reinforcing policy
On Court	Sanitization stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members must bring their own hand sanitizer for use during their game • Players must sanitize their hands before entering the court • Certain key locations will have sanitizer; one will be outside the bubble door
Tennis	Events	All events for the summer have been cancelled.
Accessories	Benches	Not available at this time.
Accessories	Water Cooler	Not available. Please bring your own water.
Clubhouse	Lounge	The upstairs lounge and kitchen facility are closed.
Clubhouse	Deck	The outside deck will be accessible from the outdoor stairs. A maximum of 8 people are allowed on the deck and social distancing must be practiced.
