Category	Item	Procedures and Protocols
Tennis	Distancing & Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three metres (3m)/ ten feet (10ft) social/physical distancing requirement in place at all times. • All members are required to practice distancing while on the property. • No handshakes, high fives, etc. • All members are asked not to touch the belongings of others. • Masks are required upon entering the property. They may be removed for playing tennis only. (Staff behind plexiglass at the front desk are exempt)
Tennis	Guest Policy	No guests are permitted
Tennis	Ball Usage / On Court Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is recommended that each player use their own balls, marked with a permanent marker. Whoever is serving uses their own balls. Other players can pass balls back to the owner by only using their racquet. Balls not in use can be set at the base of the net near the posts or the back of the court. • It is recommended that players do not change ends during the duration of a playing session. • It is recommended that players sanitize their hands periodically over the playing session, such as at water/rest breaks.
Tennis	Court Bookings / Court Times / Enter & Exit Courts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Singles only permitted • A 15-minute interval between court times is in place. • Know your court number before arrival. • Arrive shortly before your court time and only enter the bubble after the time to enter buzzer sounds. • Exit your court as quickly as possible after the end time buzzer goes. • Bookings must be made in advance online or by calling the Front Desk: (604) 922-9722. No in person bookings allowed. • Changes must be made in advance of court time via online or by calling the Front Desk.
Tennis	Balls & Stringing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Balls can now be purchased in singles cans. Only credit card payment is accepted, no cash. • Stringing service will not be facilitated through the Club. You must contact Paul or Karin directly to coordinate pick up and drop off. paul@wvtc.ca or karin@wvtc.ca
Tennis	Ball Machine	Not available at this time
Clubhouse	Washrooms, Showers & Changing rooms	Maximum 2 people at any given time in the washroom/changeroom area. Showers are not available until further notice.
Tennis	Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One coach to 4 juniors maximum for junior lessons • One coach to 1 adult (age 22+), or 2 adults living in same household, for adult lessons • Only the instructors can touch the balls with their hands.
Tennis	Waiver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All members must fill out the waiver (link below). • Minors (under age 19) must fill out the Assumption of Risk form, a parent or guardian must complete the waiver on their behalf. • Waivers must be submitted before visiting the Club. Court access will not be permitted if you have not filled out the waiver. • Links to the waivers are below and must be returned via email to sandy@wvtc.ca, or dropped off, or mailed to the Club.

On Court	Sanitization Stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members must bring their own hand sanitizer for use during their game. • Players must sanitize their hands before entering the court, sanitizer is available both outside and inside the bubble doors. • Sanitizer is available in several locations around the facility.
Tennis	Events / Socials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All socials and events have been cancelled until further notice. • There will be no member gatherings permitted on site until further notice.
Accessories	Benches	Benches must be sanitized by the exiting members each time they leave the court. Sanitizing spray bottles and paper towels are available at each court.
Accessories	Water Cooler	Please bring your own water, however if you need some there is a foot operated cooler in the lobby.
Clubhouse	Lobby & Lounge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum 2 people in addition to the desk clerk in the lobby. • The upstairs lounge and kitchen facility are closed.
Clubhouse	Deck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The outside deck is closed until further notice.
