

Our current safety protocols in place as of December 18, 2021 are as follows:

Category	Item	Procedures and Protocols
Tennis	Distancing & Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>By order of the B.C PHO, effective August 25, 2021 <b>masks must be worn indoors.</b></li> <li><b>Masks must also be worn in all outdoor waiting areas</b>, or if circumstances do not allow for safe social distancing (2 meters).</li> </ul>
Tennis	Guest Policy	Guests are NOT permitted at this time.
Tennis	Ball Usage / On Court Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It is recommended that players sanitize their hands periodically over the playing session, such as at water/rest breaks.</li> </ul>
Tennis	Court Bookings / Court Times / Enter & Exit Courts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Court bookings and duration of play time are as usual.</li> </ul>
Tennis	Stringing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stringing service will not be facilitated through the Club. You must contact Paul or Karin directly to coordinate pick up and drop off. <a href="mailto:paul@wvtc.ca">paul@wvtc.ca</a> or <a href="mailto:karin@wvtc.ca">karin@wvtc.ca</a></li> </ul>
Tennis	Ball Machine	Available as of June 17, 2021.
Clubhouse	Washrooms, Showers & Changing rooms.	<b>Maximum 4</b> in each washroom. (2 people at any given time in the washroom area and 2 in the changeroom area).
	Lobby	<b>Maximum of 4</b> people in the lobby (excluding desk staff). Players waiting to go on court are asked to wait in the outdoor tented areas, or in the covered alcove by the bubble door. <b>Masks are required in these areas.</b>
	Lounge	The upstairs lounge and kitchen facility remain closed at this time.
Tennis	Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One coach to 4 students is recommended for adults. This ratio can be increased to a maximum of 10 when coaching juniors, though standard practice is a maximum of 6.</li> </ul>
Tennis	Waiver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All members and guests must fill out the waiver (link below).</li> <li>Minors (under age 19) must fill out the Assumption of Risk form, a parent or guardian must complete the waiver on their behalf.</li> <li>Waivers must be submitted before visiting the Club. Court access will not be permitted if you have not filled out the waiver.</li> <li>Links to the waivers are below and must be returned via email to <a href="mailto:sandy@wvtc.ca">sandy@wvtc.ca</a> , or dropped off, or mailed to the Club.</li> </ul>

On Court	Sanitization Stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sanitizer is available in several locations around the facility, and it is recommended to use them when entering/exiting the courts and/or clubhouse.</li> </ul>
Outdoor areas	Deck & Patio	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The deck and patio are open to be used as normal.</li> </ul>
Accessories	Water Cooler	Please bring your own water, however if you need some there is a foot operated cooler in the lobby.
